Dear Mr. Hathaway:

I have your letter of April 21, 2008. I have reviewed the Nabholz decision. I do not believe it applies to the request. The contractor who performs work pursuant to an explicit contract with a State agency is materially different from an attorney who performs services as an agent for a school district. A realtor is more analogous to an attorney or for that matter an accountant than a contractor performing a contract on a specific project. The contractor is not an agent under the usual definition of agents. On the other hand, the attorney or accountant is an agent. I submit that a realtor is also an agent. In this case, the agent has performed the task of site selection and soliciting bids regarding school properties. He is obliged to act on behalf of the school district. The contractor is only obliged to perform the contract and not to be a continuing representative of the institution.

Are you sure that you want to decline providing the information requested?


Because of the position that you take in your letter, especially in view of the fact that Mr. Baker Kurrus has indicated that his involvement in the entity to which Mr. Mackey made an offer on behalf of the school district was suspicious, do you really want to deny us access to the information requested. Because the Little Rock School Board meets tonight, I need an answer by 3:00 p.m., which is before the public board meeting at 5:30 p.m..

By copy of this letter, I am informing Mr. Kurrus, who has suggested inquiry into his participation in the land transaction being brokered by Mr. Mackey for the school district, and the other directors request that Mr. Mackey submit the requested information to me so that litigation will not be necessary.

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I, of course, am acting on behalf of a client. That client is independently making a separate but identical request for the information that you now deny.
