

## University of Arkansas Alcohol and Drug Sanctioning Guidelines

**\*\*Please note that this document serves as a *guideline* for your Administrative Hearing Officer or All-University Conduct Board (AUCB) to utilize in determining appropriate sanctions for your matter. As such, a hearing officer or AUCB may choose to implement sanctions that are or are not listed or eliminate sanctions that are included. The implementation of the sanctions is dependent on the professional discretion of your hearing officer or the AUCB.\*\***

*\*Violations of C17 Sale, manufacture, or intent to manufacture a controlled substance or narcotic including, but not limited to, any actions or activities prohibited by Ark. Code Ann. §5-64-401 and Ark. Code Ann. §5-64-403. (see Appendix C) may result in an automatic Interim Suspension, and is not subject to the guidelines for drug violations with associated charges.*

Mandatory Alcohol/Drug Assessment by a professional mental health practitioner (licensed or certified by the State of Arkansas). The selection of the practitioner is the choice of the student.</li> <li>2. Must comply with the prescribed course of treatment or submit a rationale to the contrary for review.</li> <li>3. Cost of Assessment</li> <li>4. Parental Notification (under 21)</li> <li>5. Community Service (60hours)</li> <li>6. Suspended Parking Privileges for one (1) year. <i>Implemented in the event that the vehicle was utilized in the commission of the violation. This includes but is not limited to driving under the influence, drug/alcohol use occurred in the vehicle, substance stored in the vehicle, or vehicle used to transport the substance(s).</i></li> <li>7.
