MEMORANDUM FOR LITTLE ROCK, AK POLICE DEPARTMENT

SUBJECT: Memorandum of Agreement


1. This memorandum serves as confirmation and agreement of the training between 3rd Battalion, 160th Special Operations Aviation Regiment (Airborne) and the office representing the Mayor of Little Rock Arkansas located at City Hall, 600 West Markham, Little Rock, AR 77201. This notification confirms the pre-coordinated training at the "old Veterans Hospital" owned by the Institute for Basic Life Principles and "Moon Distributors" owned by Mr. Stan Hastings, CEO. On POD 18-19NOV11 between 2300 and 0530 Special Operations personnel will conduct full mission profile training, as previously briefed to Mayor Mark Stodola, LT Terry Hastings and appropriate city management personnel on 07 September 2011. 160th personnel will conduct all training in accordance with the established guidelines and conditions set on 07 September 2011 with any deviations thoroughly coordinated through all necessary and appropriate government officials.
2. The exercise will consist of 7-9 rotary wing aircraft, 2-3 fixed wing airframes and 80-100 Special Operation ground force personnel conducting full mission profile training as previously coordinated. Rotary wing aircraft will INFIL ground forces via fast rope and air land infiltration, and will EXFIL ground forces via vertical hoist extraction and air land EXFIL in vicinity of "Moon Distributors." Ground Force personnel will conduct force on force simmunition training as well as mechanical and explosive breaching on the target facility in accordance with previously conducted coordination and distributed guidance.
3. 160th personnel will provide the following:
 - a. On-site 160th SOAR(A) designated unit Officer in Charge (OIC) who will maintain positive control of all role-players and non-participant observers
 - b. On-site target preparation and clean-up pre-coordinated through appropriate VA Hospital facility site management
 - c. Continuous communication capability with all airframes and ground force personnel participating in the exercise over designated secure communications/frequencies
 - d. Provide appropriate air CASEVAC capabilities for any real world injuries and medical contingencies
 - e. Copies of the signed lease/property usage agreement as well as imagery request forms

- f. Public Affairs Office Officer (160th personnel) on-site throughout the duration of mission execution and will remain on-site to address any immediate PAO concerns
- g. 160th PAOs will provide official press release statements to all appropriate Little Rock Officials for dissemination
- h. 160th personnel co-located with Little Rock International Airport tower personnel to ensure airspace de-confliction
- i. 160th will provide either legal or paralegal representation on the target facility

In accordance with established requirements the 160th SOAR(A) requested the following:

- j. Little Rock, AK public affairs officials publish official notifications and door-to-door notifications of appropriate personnel through the desired media on a timeline deemed necessary by the Mayor's Office and City Officials. This coordination will comply with the guidance disseminated to local officials through the 160th SOAR(A) Public Affairs Office.
 - k. Provide LEA coordination for movement off of the "Old Veterans Hospital" to "Moon Distributors" for EXFIL of ground forces.
 - l. Provide the undersigned with an accurate list of all non-participating personnel who wish to observe the full mission profile training as soon as possible.
