Title: THEFT BY RECIEVING / NARCOTICS / IMPOUND Report Type: I

On 01/03/2012, at approximately 18:00 hours, I observed a white Chevrolet Impala traveling eastbound on Morning Glory at a high rate of speed. As I was following the vehicle I noticed that it did not have a license plate light. I initiated a traffic stop in the 5100 block of Morning Glory Street and made contact with the driver whom I recognized to be Curtis Riggs. I also made contact with the passenger, who identified himself as Franklin Griffin (DOB: 07/20/1981). Mr. Riggs was able to provide me with registration and proof of insurance for the vehicle and stated that his license was still suspended from when I stopped him last night and towed his car.

An ACIC/NCIC query confirmed that his license was still suspended for failure to appear. A Justice X-Change query of Franklin Griffin revealed a picture of a different person which indicated that the passenger was lying about his true identity. A PTS query revealed a photograph and name of a Robert Griffin (DOB: 03/02/1983) which matched to be the passenger of the vehicle. At this point, Mr. Griffin was taken into custody for Obstruction of Governmental Operations. I asked him who Franklin Griffin was and he stated, "Oh that's my brother. I have been using his name a lot to get out of trouble." An ACIC/NCIC query of Mr. Griffin revealed that he had an active Misdemeanor Theft of Property Warrant for his arrest with North Little Rock Police Department. A short time later Communications confirmed the warrant and advised that they would like a hold placed for their agency.

Once I searched Mr. Griffin, I asked Mr. Griffin if he had anything illegal on him and he stated, "I have a Crack pipe in my pants." I then located a glass pipe that was concealed inside of his pants. Once I located this, Mr. Griffin spontaneously uttered that he had another "crack pipe" in his blue jacket in the back seat of the vehicle. Due to officer experience and training I recognized these items to be used to inhale/smoke Crack Cocaine or Methamphetamines. Mr. Griffin was then secured in the back seat of my patrol unit.

I informed Mr. Riggs that I would be impounding his vehicle, per PCSO Policy, for driving on a suspended driver's license. At my request, Communications notified Phillips Brother's Wrecker Service to respond to my location. During an inventory of the vehicle, I located the following items in the back seat of the vehicle which were later secured in my patrol unit:

Since the items were still packaged, in large quantities, and appeared to have no relevance to either of the occupants in the vehicle. Also considering the fact that both individuals had prior history of theft of property I had reasonable suspicion that the items may be stolen. I made contact with Mr. Riggs and verbally read him of his Miranda Warning. Mr. Riggs stated that he understood his rights and wished to speak to me without an attorney present. I asked him who the items belonged to and he stated, "Man I am just giving him a ride and that it is his (Griffin)." I asked him if he had stolen any of the items and he stated that he had not. I asked him if he knew the items were stolen and he refused to answer.

I then made contact with Mr. Griffin and verbally read him his Miranda Warning. Mr. Griffin stated that he understood his rights and wished to speak to me without an attorney present. I asked him who the items belonged to and he stated, "Man I stole them." I asked him from where and he stated, "Man somewhere in Lonoke County...a Family Dollar and a Wal-Mart." With the assistance of PCSO Communications, I was able to contact several of the Wal-Mart and Family Dollars stores in the area but was unable to ascertain which store the items were taken from. Deputy Tippin was able to make contact with a manager at the GameStop in Jacksonville and with using the serial numbers they were able to ascertain that the items were taken from their store (See Deputy Tippin Supplement). I asked Mr. Griffin if he had been to a GameStop in Jacksonville and he stated, "Sir I got those from my buddy because he owed me money." I asked him if he knew if they were stolen and he stated, "Yes sir I did he is a big thief." I asked him who his friend was and he stated, "Man I am not going to snitch on my buddy." I then asked if Mr. Riggs had any knowledge of the items being stolen and he stated, "Yeah....I paid him 20 bucks to give me a ride to a friend's house to buy dope." I asked him if he had any narcotics in the car and he stated that he did not.

I notified my supervisor, Sgt. R. Anderson, of the situation and he instructed me to notify the on-call Investigations supervisor. I then made contact with Investigations Sergeant M. Blain and informed him of the situation. Phillips Brother's Wrecker Service responded to our location and towed the vehicle to their lot for safe keeping. A PCSO Vehicle Storage Report was completed, the yellow copy was given to Phillips Brother's Wrecker Service, and the pink copy was given to Mr. Riggs. A PCSO Tow Notification Form will be completed and mailed to the registered owner of the vehicle.

Due to the large amount of evidence and paperwork needed to be completed, both Mr. Griffin and Mr. Riggs were transported to the Northeast District Office. While at the office, Mr. Griffin stated, "Man my heart is pounding." I asked him why and he stated, "I swallowed a little over two grams of powder Cocaine after you walked back to your car to call us in. I think I need an ambulance." I immediately notified Sgt. Anderson of Mr. Griffin's condition and notified MEMS to respond to our location. A short time later, MEMS Unit 522 responded and advised that Mr. Griffin needed to be transported to the hospital. I informed Sgt. Anderson of this and then turned Mr. Riggs over to Deputy Tippin's custody for transport to PCRDF-South Intake. Mr. Griffin was charged with misdemeanor driving on a suspended driver's license, misdemeanor no license plate light, and misdemeanor theft by receiving. I then escorted MEMS Unit 522 to Baptist Springhill in North Little Rock. I was later advised by the physicians that Mr. Griffin would have to be admitted into the

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hospital for approximately 24 to 48 hours. I notified Sgt. Anderson of this and informed him that I had Misdemeanor Obstruction of Governmental Operations, (2 counts) Felony Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Misdemeanor Theft by Receiving, and Felony Tampering with Physical Evidence for swallowing the Cocaine. Sgt. Anderson informed me that since the charges were not violent crimes to release Mr. Griffin from custody and to swear out Affidavit Warrants for his arrest which will be done at a later date. I obtained the medical paperwork from the physicians regarding his admission and I had Mr. Griffin complete and sign a PCSO Medical Records Release Form; all of which will be submitted into the PCSO Property Room as Evidence.

I contacted PCSO Communications to notify North Little Rock Police Department of Mr. Griffin's medical status and that he was being released from custody to be admitted into the hospital. All of the items, with the exception of the game controllers, which were returned to the owner, will be stored in the PCSO Property Room as Evidence.

On 01/03/2012, I responded to Dep. Koch's traffic stop near the 5100 block of Morning Glory.

Upon arrival, Dep. Koch advised that the passenger in the vehicle Robert Griffin had warrants for his arrest. Dep. Koch further advised that he had misdemeanor obstruction charges on Griffen. Dep. Koch approached the vehicle and placed Griffin under arrest (handcuffed/double-locked). A crack pipe was located on Griffin's person at that time. I then made contact with Curtis Riggs in the driver's seat of the vehicle and asked him to exit the vehicle. I completed a pat down on Riggs who advised that he did not have any type of drugs or paraphernalia on his person. I advised Riggs that the vehicle would be towed per PCSO policy due to Riggs driving on a suspended dl. I advised Riggs to sit on the front of Dep. Koch's patrol vehicle at that time.

While speaking with Riggs, Dep. Koch observed multiple items in the backseat of the vehicle that appeared to be from multiple store. Dep. Koch determined that some of the items were stolen from local stores in the area. Dep. Koch spoke with Griffin who confessed to stealing some of the items in the vehicle from stores in the area. I then completed a Vehicle Storage Report and removed the items from the vehicle and placed them in Dep. Koch's patrol unit for safe keeping.

I made contact with Michael P. Phillips (Manager of GameStop in Jacksonville AR) who confirmed that the items were missing from his store. Phillips stated that he noticed the items missing after completing a inventory on the store earlier in the day. Phillips filed a report with Jacksonville Police Department in reference to the incident. Ofc. J. Williams contacted me by phone and advised the report had been completed and provided the report number 2012-00061. I again made contact with Phillips by phone who came to the Northeast District Office to obtain the stolen property for the business. Upon Phillips arrival, I took a total of 13 photos of the stolen property. I also completed a PCSO Property Receipt Form which Phillips signed on scene.

The 13 photos were placed onto a CD-Rom and placed into evidence at the Sheriff's Office.
