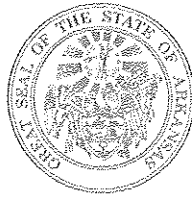

The Arkansas Judicial Discipline & Disability Commission today announced that Commission cases #10-326, 10-329 and 11-231 have been dismissed. Former Circuit Court Judge Mary Ann Gunn agreed to not serve again in the judiciary in the State of Arkansas in any capacity and the JDDC Investigative Panel dismissed all three cases without prejudice.

PUBLIC DISMISSAL LETTER

Dear Ms. Gunn:

The Judicial Discipline & Disability Commission received the above listed complaints against you alleging that you violated the Code of Judicial Conduct.

These cases involve allegations of violations of the Code of Judicial Conduct. In Cases #10-326 and #10-329, you disputed the allegations and the JDDC agreed to a dismissal of the Complaints when you retired as Circuit Judge for Washington and Madison Counties. A new complaint was made in Case #11-231, the allegations of which have not been litigated. As you have agreed that you will not serve again in the judiciary in the State of Arkansas in any capacity, as defined by Arkansas law, the Panel is dismissing these cases without prejudice.

This dismissal notice is the Commission's final action on this case and is public information.
